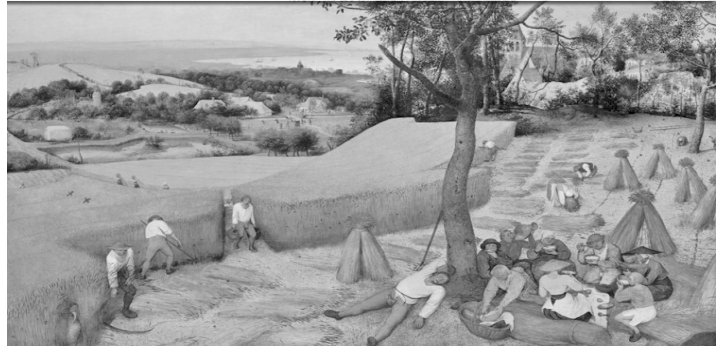

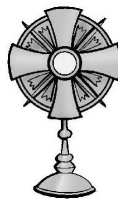

**Cascarones for the Fest-of-All:**

2. Empty the egg white and yolk and wash it out.
3. Store the shells in the carton.
