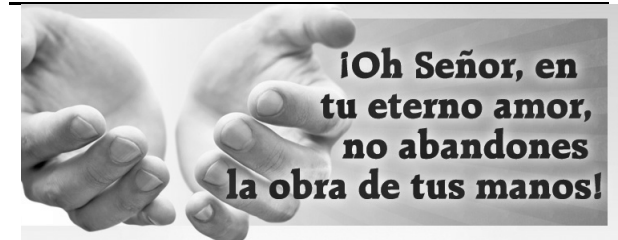
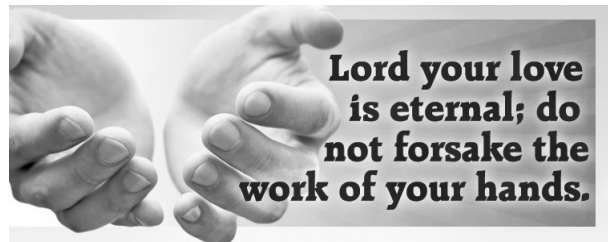

## **EIM Facilitators are needed.**

Ethics and Integrity in Ministry (EIM) .... This is a very important program in the Diocese of Austin and those who present the materials (the facilitators) are essential to the success of the EIM program throughout the Diocese. At St Joseph's we have only one facilitator and that is Deacon Jim Rodgers. We need more trained facilitators. When Deacon Jim does EIM classes for our Parish, he does the basic class (3 hours) followed by a refresher class (1.5 hours). Deacon Jim does these classes around 3 times a year. We need more facilitators. In November, the Diocese of Austin will be hosting an workshop which will get you started on being a EIM Facilitator within the Diocese of Austin.

Many of the facilitators go to other Parishes to help out, but as of right now with only one trained facilitator, Deacon Jim can only support our Parish. (He has a lot more other duties as well). If you want to sign up to be a facilitator, please call our Church Office and we will compile a list of those who want to attend the training. The Church staff will then contact you once the information of the exact date and place within the Diocese is known. Any questions, please call the Church Office (634-7878) or speak with Deacon Jim.
