Barnes and Nobel Book Fair

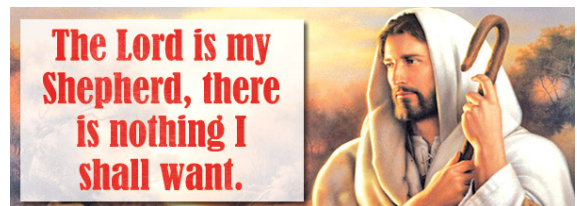
