Regarding the 1/5/2015 aggravated robbery: The individual that took the deposit to the bank on 1/5/2015 was robbed right outside the bank building. A police report was filed with the Harker Heights Police Department. The deposits consisted of the New Year's Eve and New Year's Day (1/1/2015 collection) and the weekend Masses (1/3/2015 and 1/4/2015). These deposits consisted of cash and checks. The police officer feels that the checks will most likely be discarded and the robber was just after the cash. Office staff have called those who wrote checks. If unable to be reached by phone, a letter has been sent. We are asking that if you issued a check to please be cautious and watch your accounts. Should the checks you issued to the Church for those collections be presented for payment to your bank, please provide a copy of the front and back of the check so that we can compare those to our reports and notify authorities. We are fortunate that the individual that took our deposit was not physically injured in this unfortunate incident.
