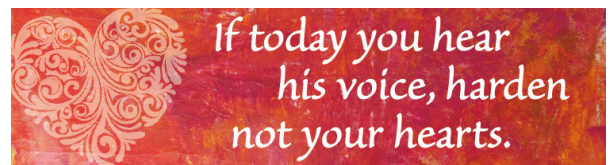

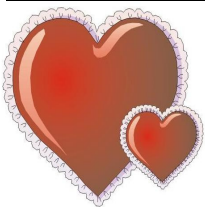

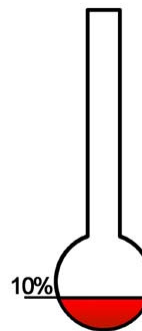
**Men's Conference**
