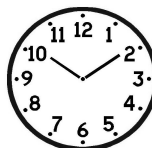

**MARK YOUR CALENDARS - St. Joseph Feast Day Celebration & St. Joseph Altar**

Mark your calendars for the celebration of our Patron Saint, St. Joseph, on Thursday, March 19. The celebration will include a procession from the Church to the Parish Activity Center after the 5:30 PM Mass and a St. Joseph Altar. All families are invited and asked to provide a meatless covered dish for the celebration.



One of the greatest traditions on St. Joseph's day is the beautifully decorated altar made to honor the Patron Saint of carpenters, fathers, and workers. Legend states that during the Middle Ages there was a severe drought and famine in Sicily. The people of the region prayed to St. Joseph, asking him to put an end to the drought and famine that had plagued the area. If he would do so, they would honor him by having a giant feast. St. Joseph answered their prayers and the people of Sicily kept their word. They prepared a giant feast to which everyone was invited, including the poor. As part of the feast, they erected an altar that consisted of three levels. The three levels, which represented the Holy Trinity, were draped in white linen and covered with flowers.

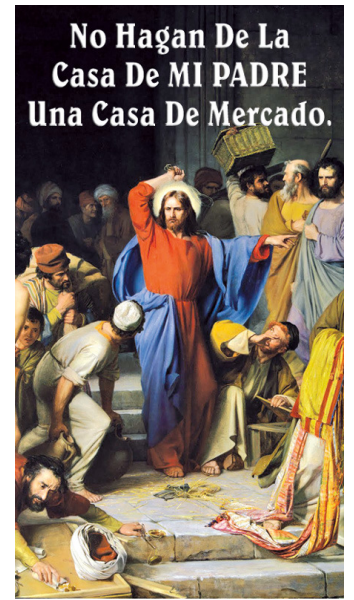
