EIM BASIC WORKSHOP - A 3-hour Ethics and Integrity in Ministry (EIM) Basic Workshop on child sexual abuse will be held May 23 from 9am-12pm in the Parish Activity Center – **please arrive promptly as late arrivals will not be permitted entrance.** All clergy and paid staff, and all volunteers working with youth and vulnerable adults, at any parish or diocesan location, are required to complete a one-time Application for Ministry prior to beginning their work/service and attend an EIM workshop within 60 days of submitting the application. Please login to your EIM account (use the Alternate Login option if needed) to pre-register to attend an EIM workshop; if you have not completed the EIM application, visit the EIM page at www.austindiocese.org to do so. Please do not bring children to an EIM workshop. Materials used in the workshop include testimonies from victims and perpetrators of sexual abuse; if you have any concerns regarding your attendance at a workshop, please contact Emily Hurlimann at (512) 949-2447 to make an alternative arrangement to receive your training. Such inquiries shall remain confidential.
