
Help Catholic Charities respond to flooding

The feast of Corpus Christi is one time when our Lord in the Blessed sacrament is exposed not just to faithful Catholics, but to all the world. This is a time when Catholics can show their love for Christ in the Real Presence by honoring Him in a very public way. It is also a wonderful way in which we can show our love for our neighbors by bringing Our Lord and Savior closer to them. So

many conversions are a result of Eucharistic Adoration experienced from inside the Church. How many more would there be if we could reach those who only drive by the Church in worldly expectations?

Today we celebrate this Great Feast Day of the Body and Blood of Christ with a Eucharistic Procession following the 12 Noon Mass. At the end of Mass, the celebrant will carry the Monstrance containing the Blessed Sacrament, vested in the Cope, down the center aisle, and out of the Church along with the Altar Servers and Deacons. You are invited to join in the procession. The celebrant will carry the Eucharist to four Altars on the Church grounds, representing the four corners of the world and the four ends of Jesus' Cross. The four Altars reflect the diversity of our Parish.

The first Altar is located directly in front of the Church. The second Altar is located adjacent to the Church, on the west side. The third is on the breezeway behind the Church. The fourth and final Altar is next to the Parish Hall. Processing to each Altar, Eucharistic Hymns will be sung. At each Altar there will be a short time of Adoration, a Gospel Reading, a prayer said by the Celebrant and Benediction, then we will proceed to the next Altar.

The procession will end as we return into the Church with a final Blessing with Benediction. Please follow the celebrant after Mass, and walk reverently and joyfully in the procession.
