## Pastor's Corner

I'd like to thank everyone here at St. Joseph for your warm welcome of both Fr. Cesar and myself! We look forward to serving you and getting to know you all better! Our readings for this week emphasize that all of us are prophets in that we are all called to share the beauty and truth of our Catholic faith with those we come in contact with. That does not mean that we will always be accepted and loved; in fact quite the contrary sometimes. If we ever feel rejection because of our Catholic faith, we can be consoled by the fact that Jesus was rejected by those he grew up with as we heard in the Gospel today. But just because the people didn't want to accept Jesus didn't mean that he felt he needed to change. Nowhere in the Gospel does Jesus ever change or water down his message just because people didn't accept him. We need to be more like Jesus and have confidence in our own Catholic faith. Yes, it will often fly in the face of our culture, but that doesn't mean that we have to change. We may certainly need to adjust our tone and the way we present the faith given any particular circumstance, but the faith can never change because "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and tomorrow." My hope is that during my tenure here at St. Joseph, we will grow together in a shared and deepened understanding of our faith, and show the world the beauty and truth of Jesus Christ and His Church.

(Sept. 2015 – May 2016)

Registrations take place on the weekends of **August 1/2 and August 8/9** after each Mass for new students. Late registration will be Wed. Aug. 19<sup>th</sup> from 6 P.M. to 7:00P.M. in the Parish Activity Center (PAC).

Returning students can register at the R.E. CENTER, Monday – Friday 10:00A.M. - 11:30P.M. and afternoons after 2:00 P.M. to 5:00P.M. beginning July 15<sup>th</sup>. **The C.C.E. office is closed between 12:00 – 1:00 for lunch.**

**Registrations will close on Friday, August 28.**

We open registrations again 3 weeks after classes begin, on Mon. Oct. 5<sup>th</sup>.

Our classes are on Mondays and Wednesdays from 6:15P.M. - 7:30P.M. Tuesday night classes are Sacramental Preparation classes and are from 6:15P.M. - 8:00P.M.

Summer is often vacation time — but it can also be a great learning time! The diocesan Office of Evangelization and Catechesis is offering a variety of courses to serve the needs of Catholic school religious educators and parish catechists in the Diocese of Austin.

This year the summer courses are also open to any adult wishing to deepen their Catholic faith and their understanding of topics such as the church's social teachings, the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA), styles and theories of adult learning, Christian leadership and more. The five Basic Teachings courses, which cover the U.S. Catholic Catechism for Adults, provide a helpful foundation for persons involved in all types of parish ministry, including CRHP and ACTS retreat presenters and teams. All courses (English and Spanish) are held at the diocesan Pastoral Center in Austin and feature instruction by experienced trainers. The courses also include printed materials and books for students.
