Wednesday, September 10 (9am-2:30pm)

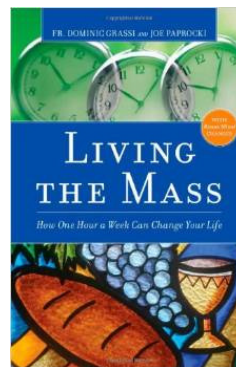

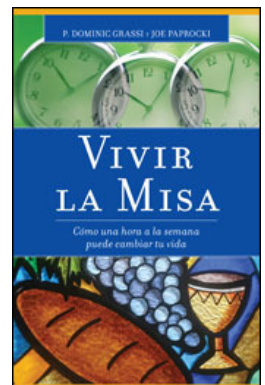
