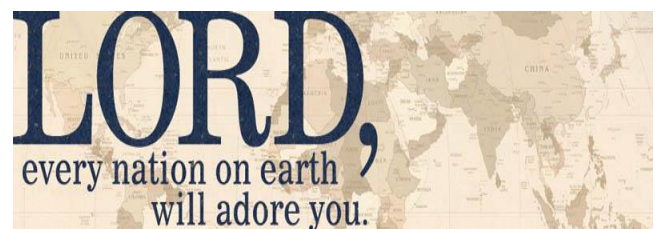

*We are all **Called to Protect.***

The three-hour Basic EIM Workshop is required for all new applicants within 60 days of submission of the EIM Application for Ministry. If you do not attend a Basic Workshop within that timeframe your EIM account will be noted as non-compliant and you will not be permitted to serve in ministry until a current workshop is recorded in your account. Your application will remain in the database while noted as non-compliant – you should not submit another EIM application.

The 1½-hour Refresher Workshop is offered only for persons who have attended a previous EIM workshop AND whose data is already recorded in an eApps application. If it has been three years or more since your last recorded workshop date, your EIM account will be noted as non-compliant and you will not be permitted to serve in ministry until a current workshop is recorded in your account. Persons needing to attend a refresher workshop may attend **either** an EIM Basic or Refresher Workshop to meet the three year refresher compliance requirement.
