Registrations take place on the weekends of **August 1/2 and August 8/9** after each Mass for new students. Late registration will be Wed. Aug. 19th from 6 P.M. to 7:00P.M. in the Parish Activity Center (PAC).

Returning students can register at the R.E. CENTER, Monday – Friday 10:00A.M. - 11:30P.M. and afternoons after 2:00 P.M. to 5:00P.M. beginning July 15th. **The C.C.E. office is closed between 12:00 – 1:00 for lunch.**

Registrations will close on Friday, August 28. We open registrations again 3 weeks after classes begin, on Mon. Oct. 5th.

Our classes are on Mondays and Wednesdays from 6:15P.M. - 7:30P.M. Tuesday night classes are Sacramental Preparation classes and are from 6:15P.M. - 8:00P.M.

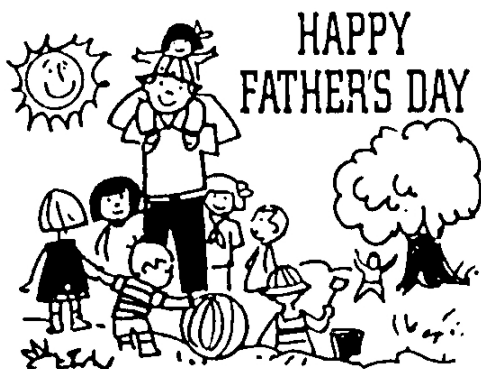
We ask for a donation of \$40.00 for one student; \$60.00 for two students; and \$80.00 for three or more.
